Founded in 1992 by Youssef Chami, Anta Akhi supports adults living with physical, mental and multiple disabilities, very dependent in their autonomy, and whose parents, advanced in age or deceased can no longer meet the requirements of their life.

- To promote a life together - different and complementary



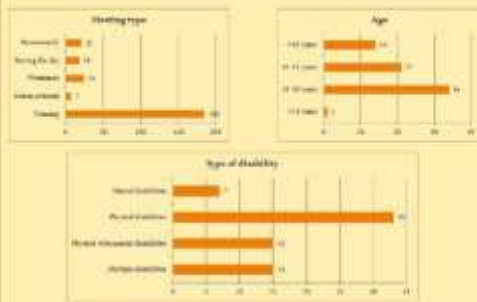
Population of Anta Akhi family

Our small family :

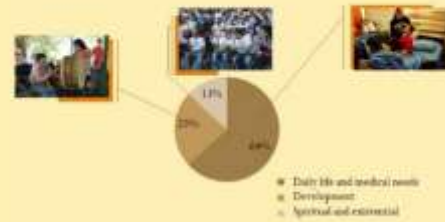

How do we spend our time ?



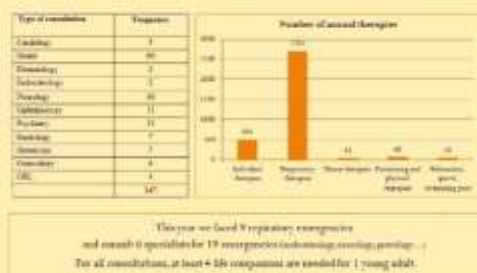
