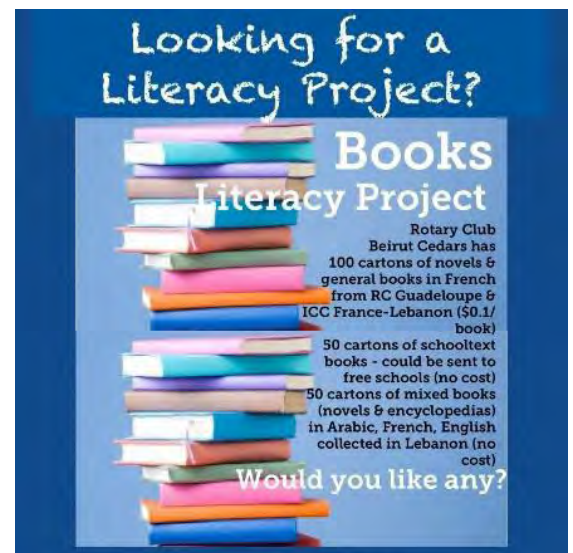

EDUCATION

A-DISTRIBUTION OF BOOKS IN SCHOOLS

In collaboration with the RCB Cedars, who received books from RC Guadeloupe & ICC France-Lebanon, the RCB was able to plan the distribution of 3500 books, as part of a Literacy Project, to 3 schools located in the south of Lebanon: Lycée Saint-Nicolas, Ain el Mir- Collège des Soeurs Salvatoriennes de Abra – Lycée N-D de Maghdouche); 3 schools in Beirut (Saints-Coeurs Sioufi; Soeurs de la Charité,.....) and to the Association Ibad el Rahman.

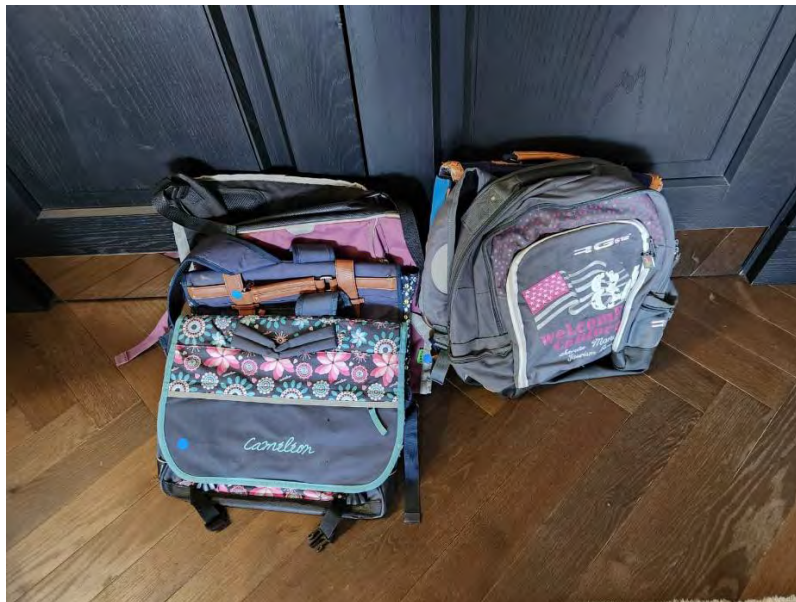
B- FUNDING PLAN FOR NEEDY PUPILS & UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (IN PROGRESS)

C - DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL BAGS (IN PROGRESS)

50 school bags were collected by Rotarian Claude Brunet from RC Lyon-Charbonnière in July; this expedition will reach Beirut before end of September.



D- LIBRARY PROJECT WITH THE ROTARACT CLUB MILLENIUM (In Progress)

In line with the upcoming Rotarian Theme for September, focusing on Education and Literacy, our Club is partnering with the Rotaract Club Millenium to create a positive impact.

Our mission is to promote literacy and address our community's educational needs.

The project has three key phases:

- 1- Book Donation Drive: The rotaractors placed collection boxes at local private schools, but they also collected over 1200 books of various genres and suitable for all ages with the generous donations that came through Rotary Beirut Cedars Lebanon . they will also promote this campaign through social media.
- 2- Fundraising and Library Construction: The library's construction will be overseen by the experienced Immediate Rotaract Past President, who is an architect, making it a valuable asset for the School.
- 3- Informative Session for Students: Following the library's establishment, the Community Service and Professional Development committee in the Rotaract club millennium will hold an educational session for students. Rotaractors will discuss the importance of reading, introduce them to different book genres, and guide them on effectively using a library.



HEALTH

A- HDF-HEARTBEAT CONGENITAL HEART DISEASE OPERATIONS (In progress)

Global Grant Overview:

Global Grant Objective: Heart surgeries at HDF for needy infants with congenital heart disease

The purpose of the project is to assist with the funding of heart surgeries to save the lives of children from needy families with congenital heart disease. The cost of a heart surgery is distributed between the Lebanese Ministry of Health, the NGO Heartbeat, the Rotary Global Grant project in addition to a special deduction from the Hotel Dieu de France (HDF) Hospital. Due to the financial and economic collapse and the collapse of the Lebanese Pound (LBP), the Ministry of Health's contribution, as it pays in LBP, has become less significant putting the onus on the NGO Heartbeat and Rotary through this Grant to compensate for the shortfall. Having said that, an average figure of 4,000 USD per surgery raised through this Global Grant will save the life of a child. This GG project aims to provide surgeries for 15 to 20 children, depending on the complexity of the cases and the exact cost of each surgery.

B- PURCHASE OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT FOR JEZZINE HOSPITAL

(Project in progress for a GG)

Project Overview

Since 2019, Lebanon is going through an unprecedented politico-economic crisis, deeply aggravated by the explosion at the port of Beirut in August 2020; furthermore, the government is bankrupt, following the collapse of the Lebanese pound.

All sectors are deeply affected, especially the health sector. Private hospitals are struggling to survive as they became too expensive to accommodate the Lebanese patients who now subsist on extremely low incomes. As for government hospitals in Lebanon, for all the above reasons, they lost all form of subsidies formerly provided by the state. Rural hospitals, located far from the capital, are particularly vulnerable; some have closed for lack of funding.

The double tragedy is that citizens, who are by now very impoverished, head toward these government centers which are, today, nearly dysfunctional.

This is the case of the government hospital in Jezzine, a city in southern Lebanon, capital of the District of Jezzine and located 73 km from Beirut, with an estimated population of 80,000. The hospital admits patients from nearby regions and villages strongly affected by internal and external emigration.

Jezzine Government Hospital is the only government hospital serving this area. It has around forty beds and provides medical services within the limits of its capacity; financial difficulties make it increasingly difficult to provide these services and maintain their quality. The families of the region consider this hospital as their only hope to have access to appropriate and professional care.

Currently, this hospital suffers from an urgent lack of medical equipment to perform certain surgical procedures. Patients are therefore referred to private hospitals quite far from their homes; they, consequently, have to deal with the

high cost of transportation (due to the outrageous price of fuel) as well as the high cost of private care that is far beyond their means.

Jezzine Hospital, once subsidized by the state and assisted by sponsors, now finds itself without any kind of support.

Attached is the list of equipment and supplies needed to restart this hospital, which is only partially functional, leaving an entire population in disarray.

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

A- EXPANSION OF THE ACSAUVEL EMBROIDERY WORKSHOP (currently seeking financial support)

Project Overview

Acsauvel - is a Civil Association for the Safeguarding of Children in Lebanon; a nonprofit organization founded in 1979 under the Executive Order 127/ A.O. It currently hosts 76 children and adults with intellectual disabilities.

Acsauvel is located in Dick el Mehdi, Notre Dame de Tamiche. The land is owned by the Maronite Congregation and was built with the support of several humanitarian international organizations.

Acsauvel holds two educational departments: The specialized education center for children aged between 3 and 17 years (C.A.R.1.S) and the protected workshop (C.A.T) which welcomes adults from 18 years old onwards. Acsauvel offers education, and supports life skill development and self - actualization.

Current Situation

Acsauvel has an agreement with the Lebanese state; the Ministry of Social Affairs pays 19,000 LBP per child per day of attendance - the equivalent of 4,560,000 LBP or \$50 per year (19,000 x 20 days on

average x 12 months) - while the education of a child at Acsauvel costs around \$2,500 yearly. Unfortunately, the last contribution of the ministry goes back to 2021.

Due to increase of living costs, inflation, and the acute economic crisis, several members of our psycho-social and pedagogical support team left Acsauvel, searching for better paid jobs. The employees' salaries do not cover the basic costs of living. Acsauvel is deeply grateful to the dedicated team that stayed on, with the association, despite all this hardship.

Meanwhile Acsauvel tries to build a sustainable and self-financed income structure for itself in order to secure international support for added benefits for its team, and sell its kitchen and embroidery products. The embroidery workshop, in particular, if expanded, will provide a considerable monthly income.

Request of Support

Acsauvel would like to further develop its embroidery workshop in order to cater for the growing needs of its clients and in the same time increase its income as well as its auto financing capacity. Unfortunately, without help, Acsauvel will not be able to make this investment. There is a quotation for an embroidery machine attached to this email and we continue to work on other quotations.

The team and the administrative board fight every day for the future of Acsauvel.

If our efforts fail, these children will hang around for days completely idle; this situation will inevitably lead to their marginalization and regression. We are driven by the mission to keep Acsauvel alive and we envision to grow. We strongly believe that all children have the right to education and to live a fulfilled and self-actualized life.

B- PURCHASE OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT FOR ANTA AKHI (Almost Finalized)

Project Overview

Sesobel was created in Lebanon, in 1976; this association cares for children with disabilities, as well as their families. When these children reach adulthood, their parents can no longer care for them, because of the financial difficulties they face in particular when dealing with heavy cases of disability, be it mental or physical.

In order to welcome and care for these young adults, the association Anta Akhi, (You are my brother) was created. The "Home of Loving Care" allows young people with disabilities to live together in dignity and joy, and to fulfill themselves in their social and spiritual life.

C- THE REHABILITATION OF THE TECHNICAL WORKSHOPS AT THE FATHER AFIF OSSEIRANE FOUNDATION:

FOYER DE LA PROVIDENCE

(currently seeking financial help)

Project Overview

Since 1950, Father Afif Osseiran took in and cared for minors, the so-called chicklets boys, and adults in conflict with the law, as well as young people from underprivileged backgrounds, with problems and in danger of delinquency. His aim was to protect them, re-educate them and re-train them to enable their reintegration into society. In 1964, Father Afif Osseiran founded the “Foyer de la Providence” to remove these young boys from the streets and give them a technical training. In 1967, this hostel became a free boarding school and a technical school officially recognized by the Lebanese state under decree 535/AD. In 1988, following the death of Father Afif Osseiran, a committee of 14 volunteer members elected by a general assembly took over the management of the Father Afif Osseiran Foundation (FPAO).

The best way to help a child in difficulty is to promote his reintegration into society,

The FPAO has set itself a mission centered on the education and the training of these young people.

The program is based on three axes: Education, Training and Integration.

- Education: Literacy and upgrading Instruction: civic and moral
- Training: Academic and technical crowned by the government patent
- Integration: Continuation of studies (BT and TS) in similar institutions and work according to their specialization and aptitude.

Urgent needs for the proper functioning of FPAO

The rehabilitation of the technical workshops (Workshops for: General mechanics, building, electricity, car mechanics) at the Foyer de la Providence.

These workshops were destroyed by the explosion of August 4, 2020

Estimated cost of the project: 11,000 USD

Project overview:

Project overview

This project started in 2015, in Beirut public schools (approximately 60 schools). The project was successfully pursued for 3 years.

It was interrupted during the COVID period, and after the explosion in the port of Beirut in 2020.

This project should be reviewed and hopefully revitalized.

Project Goals.

1. Our first goal is to initiate the next generation of our citizens to the waste sorting mechanism.

Teach young people to:

- Distinguish between the different types of waste.
- Sort waste and throw it in the appropriate bins.

- Understand the becoming of the waste, and the value of recycling.
 - Take part in safeguarding the environment.
2. Our second goal is to allow charitable associations to take advantage from our actions. The associations collect the waste sorted in schools, proceed in their recycling and allow families in need to benefit from the profits of recycling.

Future Steps

1. Get in touch with public schools again
2. Check the availability of the waste bin (offered in the past by Sukleen)
3. Check the need for plastic bags to collect the sorted waste
